AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. All bulls over the age of 6 months must be shown with a nose-lead in the halter classes.
2. To qualify for entry and judging, the following information must be provided on the entry form by closing date of entry.
 - A. Breed, identification number, name of animal and birthdate.
 - B. If registered: registration number, identification number as acceptable per breed association.

DIVISION 138 - BEEF-ALL BREEDS

01. Bull Calf under 12 months
02. Yearling Bull 12 - 24 months

03. Junior Heifer Calf Born: 1/01/19 or later
04. Senior Heifer Calf Born: 7/01/18 to 12/31/18
05. Jr/Summer Yrlg Hfr Born: 1/01/18 to 6/30/18
06. Sr. Yrlg Heifer Born: 3/01/17 to 12/31/17
07. Cow/Calf Pair- Any Beef female born before March 1, 2015 and her calf born before August 1, 2017

08. Bred and Owned (Exhibitor must have owned the dam at the time of service (breeding) for the offspring being shown).
09. Premier Beef Exhibitor – Award will be given to a 4-H/FFA Junior Exhibitor. Points will be based off of placing of beef cattle exhibited. Market, Showmanship, Junior Breeding Beef, and Open Beef Cattle will all be used in the awarding of points. Award to be given – No premiums for this class. No entry fee required for this class.

08. Junior Best Three Females – This group consists of three (3) females from heifer classes, none of which have freshened, all bred by and at least one owned by exhibitor

10. Three Year Old Cow 09/01/15 – 08/31/16
11. Four Year Old Cow 09/01/14 – 08/31/15
12. Aged Cow Born before 09/01/14
13. Dry Cow – Three years and older, must have freshened once

14. Progeny Class – Consists of dam and one progeny, either sex.
15. Produce of Dam – Consists of two animals, any age, either sex, the produce of one cow.
