AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING

All Dairy Goats must be appropriately shorn to show standards. This is not a “fuzzy” show.

Note: All goats must be properly disbudded and must be clean & long hair clipped. Goats MUST be tattooed, microchipped, or have a scrapie tag. Identification on goats; microchipped or tattooed must match registration papers and registration paper **MUST** be provided during check-in. (If microchipped please provide the reader) ADGA is a registry that works with USDA and is a responsible reporting registry for scrapie. If a goat is registered with ADGA that tattoo number is classified as the goat’s scrapie number and does not need to be tagged. **Grade animals must have scrapie tags.** All classes will be open to registered and unregistered animals.

Mini Goats are NOT allowed to enter Standard Dairy Goat Classes.
Standard Dairy Goats are NOT allowed to be entered in Mini Goat Classes.

10. Best Bred & Owned Breeding Female: Animal, male or female shown in an individual breeding class, must be bred and owned by exhibitor, to entered in this class. As a bred and owned animal, the exhibitor must own the dam at time of breeding. Entries must show proof of ownership at time of breeding. 1 entry per exhibitor, may be registered or unregistered.
