RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Showmanship entries must be written on the entry form even though there is no entry fee.
2. No more than 2 entries per class per exhibitor will be allowed.
3. All exhibitors must care for their own birds throughout the fair. If unable to do so, arrangements must be made in advance with show chairperson.

DIVISION 110 – NON-STANDARD/DQ

Any Breed, age and sex entered in wrong classes or Non-standard variety.

DIVISION 112 – BANTAMS CHICKENS

Classes:

01. Cocks, prior to 12/31/19 hatch
02. Cockerels, after 1/1/20 hatch
03. Hens, prior to 12/31/19 hatch
04. Pullets, after 1/1/20 hatch

DIVISION 113 – TURKEYS

Classes:

01. Any Breed, any age – Toms
02. Any Breed, any age – Hens

MARKET POULTRY

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per Entry

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Exhibitor must have at least one (1) additional entry in the 4-H/FFA poultry show to enter a Market Meat Pen.
2. Exhibitor may enter one (1) meat pen. All rules of 4-H or FFA show apply to Poultry Meat Pens
3. Only Blue & Red Ribbon entries will be allowed to sell at the Livestock Auction. Meat pen consist of three (3) birds of the same breed/cross/ variety.
4. Birds must be 10 weeks old and under weighing 3 ½ to 6 pounds.
5. All birds must be weighed in during official weigh-in. Official weight shall be the weight established during official weigh-in. Official weights shall be provided to the judge. If any one bird in the pen weighs more/less than the maximum/minimum weight, the entire pen is eliminated.
6. Best meat-type are those fryers that are compact, well filled rounded and with solid flesh.
7. All fryers in a pen must be in prime condition.
8. Turkeys must be hatched on or after 125 days before the first day of the current year's show. All Turkeys entered must have a leg band to be eligible to be shown. Minimum Show weight: Toms – 18 pounds; Hen – 12 pounds.
9. Conformity to breed type will be considered in judging based on following scorecard:

Symmetry	10%
Condition	10%
Wings & Shoulders	10%
Back & Spring of	20%
Breast, Length of Keel	20%
Legs, Fleshing	20%
(upper thigh 10%, drumstick 10%)	
Skin, Color, Texture &	
Distribution of fat under the skin	10%
TOTAL	100%
